SOMERSET HILLS YMCA TANNENBAUM FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP ESTABLISHED IN 2011

The Somerset Hills YMCA has established the Tannenbaum Family Scholarship to recognize a member of the Somerset Hills YMCA who is a high school senior or matriculating college student seeking a career in sports or sports related field.

Award Criteria and Information:

- The scholarship will be awarded annually to a college bound high school senior or matriculating college student
- The recipient must be a member in good standing of Somerset Hills YMCA and reside in The Somerset Hills area
- The student must pursue a sports degree at an accredited college or university
- The student must submit a completed application with supporting documents by the stated deadline
- The student must submit two letters of recommendation. One from an academic professional and one personal (not a family member).

About the Scholarship:

- The scholarship is a one year, one time award of \$1,000
- The student must submit proof of registration as a full time student at an accredited college or university in order to receive award (official college semester bill)
- Payment will be made directly to the student. Funds are to be used for educational purposes only
- The scholarship will be paid in full in August for the fall semester.
- All applicants will be interviewed by YMCA representatives on the Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Application deadline: April 30, 2018
